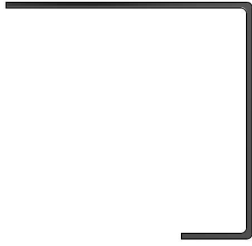




## DRY BENCH

A dry bench or flat bench is designed to allow for easy cleaning due to its flat design it does not hold or contain liquid.

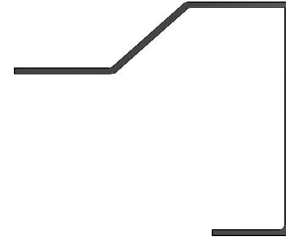


## DRY BENCH EXAMPLE

A wet bench is designed to hold and contain liquids due to its lip. Wet areas are generally found in dishwasher areas in kitchens, and away from power supply.

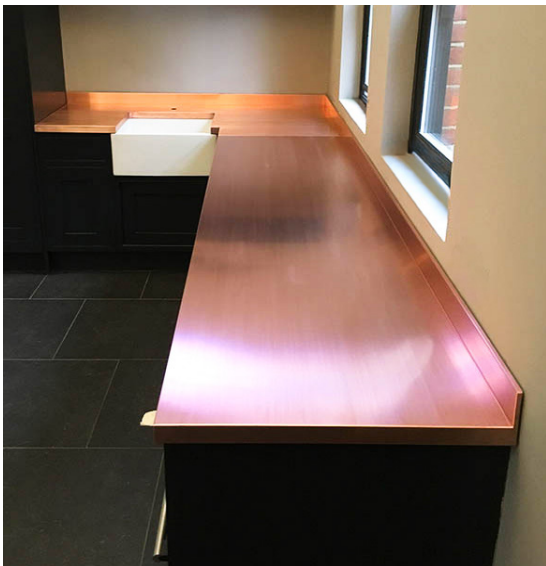

## WELD IN SINK EXAMPLE

The benefit of a weld in sink is the benchtop runs straight into the sink, making the area exceptionally flat, clean and hygienic and eliminates the need for a visible sink rim which can be difficult to clean.
